STANDING ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984, it is hereby ORDERED:

- (1) That all cases under title 11 of the United States Code and all proceedings arising under title 11 or arising in or related to a case under title 11 are referred to the bankruptcy judges for this district;
- (2) That personal injury tort and wrongful death claims shall be tried in the district court in which the claim is pending, or in the district court in the district in which the claim arose, as determined by the district court in which the bankruptcy case is pending; and
- (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Order, the district court, with the consent of all the parties to the proceeding, may refer a proceeding related to a case under title 11 to the bankruptcy judge to hear and determine and to enter appropriate orders and judgments, subject to review under section 158 of title 11.
